1st Flush “Wonder Gold”

Think of delicate tropical fruits and florals with this 1st flush Darjeeling.

It was picked from Gopaldhara, one of the region’s highest garden.

Altitude: over 6,000 ft

Fruity-florals. Sweet, smooth finish.

2nd Flush Grand Reserve (Black)
Lot Djl12 (Organic) 60 Kg Produce £6.50

Sweet grape, florals, soft tannins, dry grape-skin finish.

I was picked from Makaibari garden, the garden was the first to be organic certified in Darjeeling.

Makaibari is 70% natural forest, practicing bio-diverse farming

2nd Flush Premium Assam
Lot 367 (Organic) £5.00

A subtly sweet tea with prized malty notes, a full body, creamy texture and dry finish.

This Assam come from Belseri Estate in the Dhekiajuli Belt from the June season.

Altitude: 340 ft above sea level.

2014 Jun Chiyabari
Himalayan Mist Oolong
Lot J79 (Organic) 10kg Produce £8.50

This micro batch is delicate and intense; high notes of stewed stone fruit evocative florals and vibrant acidity.

The large leaves of this gently oxidised oolong will infuse several times.

Altitude; 5,200- 6,500 f above the seal level.

This special lot was picked from the prized Ichibancha season (first flush)

It was lightly steamed giving it a wonderful, deep umami flavour profile.
